Primary Reserve Co-op Program Information Sheet

The Primary Reserve Co-op Program consists of the 3 main components:

- Military Training (Co-op, PPL408, 2 credits)
- Physical Training (Physical Education, PPL401, 1 credit)
- Class Time (Various courses, 1 credit)

Courses offered during Class Time are:

- Any Math course offered from grade 9 to 12
- Some English courses (if required for graduation or SHSM)
- Other courses in consultation with the Primary Reserve Co-op Teacher

A <u>Teacher</u> (an employee of the HWDSB) works at the John W. Foote Armoury and has the following duties:

- Teach and assist students during class time and physical education
- Monitor students during military and physical training
- Complete all paperwork required for co-op, course preparations, evaluations and SHSM
- Counsel students on timetable requirements and other Primary Reserve co-op program issues
- Liaison with military personnel, parents and HWDSB employees

The Primary Reserve Co-op Program gives students an opportunity to achieve a <u>Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM)</u> in <u>Justice</u>, <u>Community Safety and Emergency Services</u> by completing the following courses and components:

- Co-operative Education, Physical Education and grade 11 Math (or grade 12 English)
- CPR and Standard First Aid
- WHMIS, fire extinguisher use, conflict resolution, navigation and safe weapon handling

To complete all of the components of the SHSM, other courses are required to be completed in grade 11 and 12 at the student's home school. Students will need to contact their guidance counsellor or co-op teacher to inform them they are trying to achieve this SHSM.
